Everything possible is built into the price; Motorcycle rental, guides, accommodation, all food and all bike fuel, plus of course our industry leading support services are included in the price, along with the chance to sample the latest Ducati motorcycles on America's greatest roads. All you need to do is get there (Sacramento airport—airport code *SMF*)

2012 will see Multistrada 1200, Diavel, Hypermotard and Monster models available for these tours with a choice of Superbikes joining the fleet later in the year.

Day 1 Our meeting point is at the state Capitol city of Sacramento (we will collect you from the airport or your hotel, or you can meet us at our new offices) around mid to late morning allowing us to complete required paperwork and depart for an afternoon ride into the hills to the east. We will take a detour along the impressive roads of Mosquito Ridge as a first chance to show you what real riding, Californian style, is all about before heading to the northern end of beautiful Lake Tahoe and our first overnight stop.

Today's ride 188 miles – trip total 188 miles



Day 2 The most amazing roads and breath-taking beautiful scenery will fill the day. From Tahoe we head north through the wooded mountainsides of the Tahoe National Forest before jumping onto Route 36 for an eastern pass towards the Pacific Coast. If curves are your thing, today is (again!) your day. 344 miles, most of it on the side of your tyres!

Overnight we are staying in a stylish Inn immersed in the midst of enormous Redwoods, synonymous with this region of Northern California

Today's ride 344 miles – trip total 532 miles



Day 3 The first of 2 days of heading south on the awesome **Pacific Coast Highway**. Words really cannot prepare you for the sensory overload that this road represents, colours, smells, sights and then there is the ride! This is one of the world's most famous roads and it will not disappoint! Other than the Pacific Coast Highway itself, highlights include crossing the famous Golden Gate bridge into San Francisco, and the descent into beautiful Half Moon Bay for our next overnight halt

Today's ride 292 miles –trip total 824 miles



Day 4 Onward to the south staying with the PCH, past Santa Cruz, **Monterey**, Carmel, **Big Sur**, Ragged Point **and more**. To add even more to a already heady mix of roads and landscapes, we take a brief detour up into the hills around Cambria (or if you feel like a rest, put your feet up and enjoy the view for half an hour!) before resuming our southerly heading down to stylish Santa Barbara, which will form our base for the next two nights

*** The July edition of the tour varies with a return northwards from Cambria to our selected hotel at Ragged Point for easier access to Laguna Seca for the MotoGP

Today's ride 348 miles – trip total 1172 miles



Day 5 Today provides the opportunity of a rest day for anyone in the mood, or we will be running a trip down past Malibu and on to some local hot spots, such as **Hollywood**, Beverly Hills and more

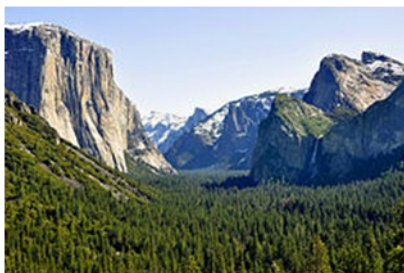
*** The July edition of the tour includes an early ride up to the track of Laguna Seca, grandstand tickets for the **MotoGP race** and then a return to our hotel

Today's ride 200 miles – trip total 1372 miles



Day 6 If there is one inescapable fact, it is that America is BIG, and California takes up a large part of America. It becomes inevitable that at some point we must cover some miles crossing the central plains. Don't worry, the start and end of the day are filled with more first class roads, finally heading into the volcanic mountains of the **Sierra Nevada** towards the famous **Yosemite** and **Sequoia** parks

Today's ride 316 miles – total 1688 miles



Day 7 Keep your eyes open for bears! You will never forget the countryside that you see in this week, the **range and diversity** is incredible and today will do nothing more than over fill your already crowded memory banks. We head into the heart of the Yosemite national park before threading our way into the heart of the gold-rush area. Tonight's stay will be in a hotel that evokes the period of the wild wild west

Today's ride 292 miles – total 1980 miles



Day 8 The last half day of riding takes us along the foothills around the Eldorado national forest for a few more hours before dropping us back into Sacramento for your final stop. We will be pleased to transport you to your selected hotel or the airport, or help you organise your next step!

Today's ride 140 miles – total 2120 miles
